

2021 ENHANCED HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Pittsburgh RV Show will introduce a variety of enhanced health and safety measures to minimize the spread of coronavirus.

Participants at the 2021 show must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Do not enter if you are sick or have tested positive for COVID-19
- Maintain social distance of 6 feet
- Wear face covering in facility at all times
- Sanitize hands when entering and leaving facility
- Follow directional signage
- Understand that total occupancy of people in the Convention Center at any given time will be limited

Exposure to COVID-19 is an inherent risk in any public location where people are present; we cannot guarantee you will not be exposed during your visit.

The CDC advises that older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness from Coronavirus. Guests should evaluate their own risk in determining whether to attend. People who show no symptoms can spread Coronavirus if they are infected. Any interaction with the general public poses an elevated risk of being exposed to Coronavirus. By coming to the Pittsburgh RV Show, you acknowledge and agree that you understand and assume these inherent risks associated with attendance.
